MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum No. 10 - Voting Action Plan

1. Purpose: This action plan augments the Army's Implementing Instructions for the Conduct of the Army Voting Assistance Program (2008-2009). It provides additional 551st Signal Battalion guidance and information to be used in conjunction with other requirements specified in the Army's Implementing Instructions.

2. References: The principal reference is the Army's Implementing Instructions for the Conduct of the Army Voting Assistance Program (2008-2009) forwarded electronically to Voting Assistance Officers (VAO) and Unit Voting Assistance Officers (UVAO) in September 2007. This document along with the Fort Gordon Voting Assistance Plan provides additional references applicable to the Army Voting Assistance Program (AVAP). 4. Responsibilities: The Army's Implementing Instructions for the Conduct of the Army Voting Assistance Program (2008-2009) as well as TRADOC and Installation Voting Action Plans provide detailed responsibilities and constitute the Army's Action Plan.


SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum No. 10 - Voting Action Plan
