The MOS 25R30-C45 ALC is not required by the NCOES for permanent promotion to Staff Sergeant, but is required for consideration and eligibility for SFC. It is designed to provide the individual soldier the skills required to perform at Skill Level 3 and 4. The course provides training on critical tasks identified by the Critical Task Site Selection Board for training during ALC.

The Advanced Leaders Course ALC provides Soldiers selected for promotion to Staff Sergeant with an opportunity to acquire the leader technical and tactical values, attributes, skills, and actions (VASA) needed to perform mission assigned tasks.

The Visual Information Equipment Operator/Maintainer course consists of one phase. This phase is conducted and provides students with technical training in the areas of leadership, communications skills, training management, and various signal equipment pertaining to their MOS.

MODULE A: Common Signal Leadership

MODULE B: Established a Visual Information Maintenance Program

MODULE C: Field Training Exercise (FTX)

Examinations shall be administered IAW with the Course Management Plan to ensure learning took place. Examinations will be designed to test the skills developed and the knowledge acquired during that module. The examinations may include skills and knowledge acquired in preceding modules if they are applicable to or if they support the skills and knowledge being examined.
